Backflow Prevention In order to prevent the contamination of drinking water, backflow devices are tested annually. CALL: 513-732-7496

Bathing Beach Sampling Weekly water samples are taken at the six bathing beaches in Clermont County during peak times. CALL: 513-732-7499

Birth and Death Certificates Issues Ohio birth and Clermont County death certificates. Birth requests can be made online. Clermont County records can be viewed in office. CALL: 513-732-7419

Body Art Program Prevents the spread of disease through tattooing and body piercing. CALL: 513-732-7499

Breastfeeding Support Lactation consultant and breastfeeding peers lead classes for prenatal women and support groups for postpartum women. CALL: 513-732-7453

Children with Medical Handicaps Healthcare program offered by the ODH to provide programs that link families with providers and can help pay for some of the medical services of eligible children. CALL: 513-735-8400

Coalition for Activity and Nutrition Works to address the epidemic of obesity in Clermont County. CALL: 513-735-8400

Communicable Disease Investigates and monitors reportable diseases and implements measures to prevent the spread of disease. CALL: 513-735-8400

Emergency Preparedness Plans, trains and prepares for disease outbreaks, natural disasters and acts of terrorism that require community response in conjunction with other local response organizations. CALL: 513-732-7499

Epidemiology Works to determine the distribution and causes of communicable diseases. CALL: 513-735-8400

Food Protection Program Regulates and inspects food establishments and vendors to ensure proper safety and sanitation. Also conducts food safety training. CALL: 513-732-7499

Homeowner Mound Training Allows homeowners to be their own service provider for Wisconsin and Millennium mounds. CALL 513-732-7499

Household Sewage Treatment Systems (HSTS) Ensures septic tanks and other on-site sewage disposal systems are properly installed and operating correctly to prevent the spread of disease. CALL: 513-732-7499

Immunizations Offers recommended childhood and adult vaccinations. CALL: 513-735-8400

Injury Prevention Works to reduce the number of injuries resulting from prescription drug abuse. CALL: 513-735-8400

International Travel Vaccinations Provides CDC recommended immunizations for travelers heading to areas outside of the USA. CALL: 513-735-8400

Loan Inspections Water and sewage inspections are provided for individuals interested in buying or selling a home. CALL: 513-732-7499

Manufactured Home Park Program Evaluates safety and sanitation on behalf of the Ohio Manufactured Homes Commission. CALL: 614-734-6010

Ohio Buckles Buckeyes Provides child safety seats and booster seats to eligible low-income families. CALL: 513-735-8400

Operation Permit Assessments All household sewage treatment systems in the county are assessed on a routine schedule. CALL: 513-732-7499

Plumbing Inspections Approves plumbing plans and inspects residential and commercial plumbing construction to comply with state and local codes. CALL: 513-732-7499

Prevent Blindness Ohio Assists Clermont County residents in getting a free eye exam and/or glasses. Call: 513-735-8400

Private Water Systems Oversees installation of private water systems and samples cisterns and wells as requested. CALL: 513-732-7499

Public Health Nuisance Complaints Investigates public health hazards reported by citizens. CALL: 513-732-7499

Rabies Prevention Program Monitors potential rabies exposure through animal bite investigations and specimen testing. CALL: 513-732-7499

Recreational Vehicle Park Program Ensures proper maintenance, sanitation and safety during seasonal inspections. CALL: 513-732-7499

Resident Camp Program Inspects camps to ensure health, safety and sewage standards are maintained. CALL: 513-732-7499

School Inspection Program Evaluates procedures and inspect school grounds for health and safety hazards. CALL: 513-732-7499

Sewer and Water Inspections Connections, pitch, backfill and materials used are inspected when tapping into public sewer or public water systems. CALL: 513-732-7499

Smoke Free Ohio Investigates smoking complaints in public facilities on behalf of the Ohio Department of Health. CALL: 1-866-559-6446

Solid Waste Ensures compliance with OEPA rules through inspections. CALL: 513-732-7499

Subdivision and Existing Lot Reviews Evaluates land to ensure adequate accommodation of a wastewater treatment system. CALL: 513-732-7499

Swimming Pool/Spa Program Inspects public swimming pools and spas for health and safety, water quality and general operations. CALL: 513-732-7499

Tobacco Cessation Provides tobacco cessation counseling sessions for individuals wishing to quit smoking or smokeless tobacco. CALL 513-735-8400

Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Provides nutrition education and access to nutritious foods for qualifying pregnant and postpartum women and children from birth to five years of age. CALL: 513-732-7329
