

President Proclaims National Alcohol and Drug Addiction Recovery Month

On August 31, President Barack Obama proclaimed September 2016 as National Alcohol and Drug Addiction Recovery Month to address the stigma associated with substance use. The theme for the month is "Join the Voices for Recovery: Visible, Vocal, Valuable!" Also on that day, the White House observed International Overdose Awareness Day, featuring a video with Baltimore City Health Commissioner Dr. Leana Wen and Montgomery County (MD) Police Chief Thomas Manger about how to administer life-saving naloxone to people undergoing an overdose.
