



Receiving Temperature Log

Instruction: Record the receiving temperature of Time Temperature Controlled for Safety (TCS) foods that are received from an approved source. If food temperatures are outside the required temperature zone, notify the person-in-charge and take immediate corrective action.

Note:

- All refrigerated TCS food shall be received at 41°F, unless specified in the Ohio Uniform Food Safety Code 3717-1-03.1 (H).
- A food that is labeled and shipped frozen by an approved source shall be received frozen and show no signs of temperature abuse (e.g. ice crystals)
- All hot held TCS food shall be received at 135°F or above.
